

Plans on Exhibition

Council is currently seeking feedback on the draft Integrated Strategic Plan 2018/19 which includes the Delivery Program and Operational Plan (DPOP), Budget, Fees, Charges and Services.

The Integrated Strategic Plan 2018/19 outlines the community's aspirations and long-term vision for the City. It is prepared by Council in collaboration with and on behalf of residents, businesses, all levels of government and local agencies, to help build and maintain a vibrant and sustainable future for the local community.

Each year, as part of the planning for the future financial year, Council reviews the Integrated Strategic Planning documents (DPOP, Budget, Fees and Charges, Financial) and sets the budget for the new financial year. The Operational Plan Actions are reviewed as part of this process, to set out the proposed actions that will be undertaken over the 2018/19 financial year, in accordance with the proposed budget.


The Shoalhaven Entertainment Centre is celebrating their 10th birthday on 5 July, and they are giving you the gift of winning tickets

Materials suitable for disposal include acids, alkalis, batteries, fire extinguishers, fuels, fertilisers, gas bottles, herbicides, motor oils and fluids, paints, pesticides, poisons, pool chemicals, oven and household cleaners, solvents and any unknown chemicals you may have.

Fluorescent light tubes are suitable to be disposed of via this service also.

Local Heritage Assistance Grants Now Available

Council is continuing its commitment to local heritage with the provision of grant funds to assist owners of heritage items listed in the Shoalhaven Local Environmental Plan 2014. The fund provides grants of up to \$5,000 for a range of small heritage projects such as minor maintenance and conservation works, adaptive reuse and conservation management plans. Successful applicants are required to match the grant funding amount, dollar for dollar, from their own funds.

Information on eligibility and assessment criteria is available on the application form on Council's <u>website</u> and is also available at the City Administration Centre, Bridge Road Nowra or the Ulladulla Administration Building in Deering Street, Ulladulla.
