Bridge Huskisson Update - The project has been progressing well despite the recent weather.

Over the coming weeks roadworks will include:

- The form work for the bridge deck will remain in place for the next week to allow the concrete to cure, and will then be removed.
- There are some minor finishing works to be completed on the bridge.
- The approach footpaths will be completed.

Keep up to date on road projects

Sanctuary Point - Kingsford Smith Crescent and Paradise Beach Road will be closed until mid-September.

Ulladulla - Pavement rehabilitation works at Ulladulla Harbour south car park are scheduled from Wednesday, 27 June to Friday, 29 June weather permitting. Temporary closure of the car park and boat ramp will be required during the construction period.

Please note that all quoted completion dates are subject to change due to weather conditions, emergencies or other unforeseen interruptions.

- The hand railing will be installed early July.
- Traffic controls will be removed to enable two way road use when safe to do so for any adjoining works remaining.

The bridge and footpath is expected to be fully open by late July.

Numbaa - Jindy Andy Lane - Is open to traffic from the intersection of Greenwell Point Road to Comerong Island Road. Note that the road is still under speed restriction until all operations are complete. A final seal will go on the road in the coming months.

Bomaderry 50m Pool Temporarily Closed

Bomaderry Aquatic Centre 50 metre pool will be closed from Thursday, 5 July to Monday, 6 August for scheduled maintenance. Works include essential preventative maintenance.

The indoor 25m pool will remain open to the public as usual during this period. Nowra Aquatic Pool is open Monday to Friday from 6am- 6pm and weekends 11am to 3pm.

River pontoons off to the Boat Show

Anyone crossing the Northbound Shoalhaven River bridge on Monday, 25 June 2018 might have noticed eleven big pontoons being craned out of the river.

The river floating pontoons that were in place adjacent the Nowra Wharf for the last year, have been hired for use by the International Boat Show at Darling Harbour Sydney.

International Boat Show organisers have rented the pontoons due to their diversity in



being modular and easily movable for water events. This will provide a good return on investment via rental income which will be used to further improve waterways infrastructure.

This is just one example of how Council is using assets wisely for revenue generation.

The pontoons will be back in time for the sixth Shoalhaven River Festival on Saturday, 27 October 2018.
