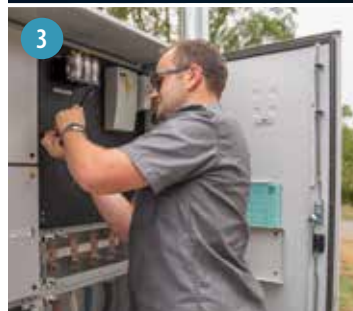
Proudly Shoalhaven stars 20 local business owners who share their business journey on why they chose the Shoalhaven to live, work and play.

Backyard Swimming Pools

A child can drown in as little as 300 mm of water.



It is important that all pool owners check their swimming pool fencing regularly and ensure that the access gate is self-closing and latching. This message equally applies to inflatable and portable pools.

Council plays an important role in the education of backyard pools including: assisting pool owners to register their pool and supporting residents with pool safety enquiries.

Council also inspects swimming pools situated on commercial premises where there is tourist or visitor accommodation.

Council's Environmental Health Officers annually inspect public and semi-public pools prior to the summer season to ensure water quality in these pools are maintained at a high standard to protect the health of swimmers.
