Helicopter Flypast


Eyes to the sky in the Nowra CBD at 6.40pm for the Naval Helicopter Flypast.

The Freedom of Entry celebrations coincides with 70 years of HMAS Albatross calling Nowra home so it is only appropriate that a ceremonial flight by a group of Albatross Helicopters honours service men and women at the event.

Beat to Quarters and Ceremonial Sunset

At 8:00pm at the intersection of Junction Street and Kinghorne Streets in Nowra watch the Navy Beat to Quarters and Ceremonial Sunset, which is derived from amongst the oldest of naval ceremonies dating back centuries to the age of sail. Originally, the ship's drums were beaten as a call for the Ship's Company to man their quarters, or action stations, when battle was imminent. It is extremely rare for the ceremony to be conducted outside of a Royal Australian Navy base or ship.

Ceremonial Sunset reflects the worldwide naval tradition of saluting the lowering of the flag at sunset each day in ships in harbour and shore establishments.



A special volley (military volley gun salute) will take place at the end of the Ceremonial Sunset, to close the event (at approximately 8:35pm). Read more on <u>Council's website</u>
