#### **ROAD CLOSURES**

Junction Street (Junction Court) - Junction Street, between Kinghorne Street and O'Connell Lane, (Junction Court), Nowra, will be closed to traffic from 7:30am Monday, 5 March to 3pm to Friday, 9 March 2018. Moss Vale Road will be closed in both directions between Barfield Road and Kangaroo Valley Road, each Sunday to Thursday night, from Sunday 25 February to Thursday 22 March, between 7pm and 5am

During this closure RMS will be completing slip repairs, as well as resurfacing the eastern side of Cambewarra Mountain.

#### **ROAD RESEALING**

A bitumen road resealing program will be undertaken in the following locations commencing Monday, 5 of March 2018 and are scheduled for completion by Friday, 16 March 2018.

- Currarong: Currarong Road.
- Tomerong: Turpentine Road
- Sussex Inlet: Sussex Inlet Road

The closure will allow for repairs to be undertaken to the road. The road will remain closed for a couple of days after the works have been completed to allow the materials to gain full strength before the road re-opens to traffic. Works will proceed subject to weather conditions.

### Ulladulla Pool Moves Forward

A new filtration system will soon be installed at the <u>Ulladulla Leisure Centre.</u>

A new kiosk and software will also be installed, adding new items for sale in the sports shop and cafe.

The Leisure Centre has applied for a 24 hours gym access which is currently with Crown Lands for their review and is expected to be operational by June this year if approved.

Ulladulla Leisure Centre infrastructure improvements will cost approximately \$750,000 ensuring Council invest in this facility as the premium recreational facility in the area.

Other long term projects include improvements to amenities including additional outdoor facilities.

# Council assists with funding for Culburra Skate Park

Shoalhaven City Council has allocated \$75,000 to the Youth Skate Park Project at Curley's Bay Recreational Park, Culburra Beach, providing funding for an accessible toilet amenity as part of the final stage 3 of the park build.

The Curley's Bay Recreational Park project committee requested Shoalhaven City Council provide additional funding to plan and build the toilet amenity at Curley's Bay Reserve.



Council acknowledged and thanked Mr Alex McNeily and the committee for their work to date in fundraising and rallying the community to get behind the Youth Skate Park.

The park currently attracts 60-90 users per day in the off-peak season.
