Roads and Works Update



Pyree *Greenwell Point Road* – Rehabilitation works will soon commence at Greenwell Point Road, Pyree.

The works will be undertaken between Pyree Lane and Bournes Lane. This project involves the widening and the stabilisation of the existing pavement placement of a new gravel overlay and spray seal.

The works will be undertaken in a single stage of construction and are scheduled to

Black Forest *Bolong Road Shoulder* - Roadworks will commence shortly on Bolong Road for widening and overlay (approximately 400m to 1000m east of Broughton Creek) and reseal (approximately 1000m to 1800m east of Broughton Creek). The works are expected to be completed by August 2018 (weather permitting). Works will be undertaken by contractors Select Civil Pty Ltd.

Traffic control will be in place during the works.

Conjola *Bendalong Road* – Road rehabilitation and widening over 1.1kms, commencing 1.6kms for the intersection of the Princes Highway have commenced and are scheduled to be undertaken from 5 February to 18 May 2018, weather permitting. The road will be reduced to a single lane and traffic lights will be in operation during the works. Motorists will experience short delays.

Ulladulla, *Deering Street* - Works will commence for the shared user pathway Stage 1 and the construction of approximately 340m of concrete pathway

be undertaken from 26 March to 1 June 2018, weather permitting. During the works, traffic lights will be used to control traffic and reduce travel to a single lane.

Vehicles entering the road from the site (between traffic lights) will need to give way and enter the flow of traffic.

2.5m wide. Works will commence at the Ulladulla Soccer Fields and continue towards the Lighthouse for approx. 340m.
