Waste Depot Opening Hours for Christmas


Council's Recycling and Waste Depots have announced additional opening days from Thursday, 27 December 2018 to Thursday, 31 January 2019.

Child Resistant Barriers Help Save Lives

Owners of backyard swimming pools and spas are legally required to register their swimming pool and/or spa on the NSW Swimming Pool register. If you haven't, you can still [register your pool](#).

Registration is free. Fines of \$220 may be issued for pools or spas that have not been registered. This applies to all pools and spas capable of holding 30cm or more of water, including those that are portable and inflatable. [Read more on Pool Safety here](#).
