Compliant Child-Resistant Barriers are required by law to be installed around pools and spas, including private and commercial holiday rental properties.

Fences keep kids safe

Owners of backyard swimming pools and spas are legally required to register their swimming pool and/or spa on the NSW Swimming Pool register.

Any pool that holds more than 30cm or more of water, including a pool or spa needs to have a child resistant barrier in place.
