use of the courts. The ideas are limitless with some feedback already received suggesting; creating community gardens, converting it to a mini soccer/netball or basketball court, or opening the space.

NAIDOC Awards

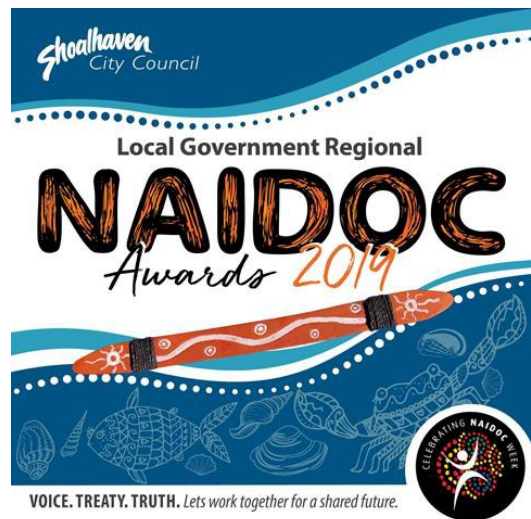
Nominations for our [2019 Regional NAIDOC Awards](#) program are now open.
