- ✔ Observe all signage including fire bans
- ✔ Dogs must be kept on a leash
- ✔ Maintain friendly and safe behaviour
- ✔ Use bins for all litter, or take it home
- ✔ Ensure all fires are contained and completely extinguished prior to sleeping or vacating
- ✔ Only use designated tracks, roads and parking areas
- ✔ Collect fallen timber only
- ✘ NO illegal or dangerous activities & substances such as firearms, illicit drugs, fireworks, slingshots, or bows & arrows
- ✘ NO littering, burying or burning rubbish
- ✘ NO lopping or cutting down trees and vegetation or harming wildlife
- ✘ NO unregistered vehicles & motorbikes
- ✘ NO petrol driven power boats on dam
- ✘ NO camping outside designated areas
- ✘ NO chainsaws
