

## DOG ACCESS – NARRAWALLEE BEACH

Shoalhaven City Council is seeking comment on proposed permanent dog access arrangements at Narrawallee Beach.

**NORTH:** The northern section of Narrawallee Beach and Narrawallee Beach Reserve will remain dog prohibited.

**CENTRAL:** Dogs will be permitted off-leash from the Matron Porter Drive Reserve access track north to the unnamed island.

**SOUTH:** The southern part of Narrawallee Beach will remain dog-prohibited. On-leash transit of dogs from Surfers Avenue to the off-leash area will not be permitted.
