### Major Projects Update

#### Shoalhaven Indoor Sports Centre

Construction is in advanced stage and subject to favourable weather conditions, anticipate handover for fit out, commissioning, mobilisation and transition in early 2019 with opening mid 2019. \$2.8m has just been received from the Federal Government through the Community Development program towards the fit out of the centre.

#### Artie Smith Oval Redevelopment

Detail design is progressing and a 30% design review meeting has been held with stakeholders. An update report will go Council in December. Aiming to have 60% detail design at this stage with a preliminary QS cost estimate. Actively seeking grant opportunities to fund the development.

#### Boongaree (Berry District Park)

Detail design completed following stakeholder consultation and an estimate of probable construction / delivery cost has been prepared. A report will go to Council in December.

#### Floodlighting Upgrades

Progressively upgrading floodlight controller systems with upgrades to floodlighting and / or electrical supply systems as needed when matching grant funding becomes available. Commencing with the added area at Nowra Showground.

## Major Projects Update

- Voyager Park Huskisson
  - The new memorial is completed and works continue on the Voyager Park entrance.
- Bay & Basin District Library
  - Council resolved at its meeting of 13 November to confirm Francis Ryan Reserve as the site for a new district library at Sanctuary Point. Staff will commence master planning process to include a concept design.
- Milton/Ulladulla Croquet Club Croquet Courts at Ulladulla Sports Park
   Detail design is completed, stakeholder consultation ongoing with croquet club and will be going to tender for construction in December 2018 / January 2019.
- Dog Off-Leash Policy
  - Council has resolved that the review of this Policy be brought forward from 2020. A request for quotation will shortly be issued with a subsequent report to Council to appoint an independent organisation to facilitate the review in the first half of 2019.
- Corporate Information Systems Replacement
  - Major I.T. Project to replace our suite of corporate I.T. systems. Well progresses with a go-live date of early December for our Property & Rates System and Water Billing.
