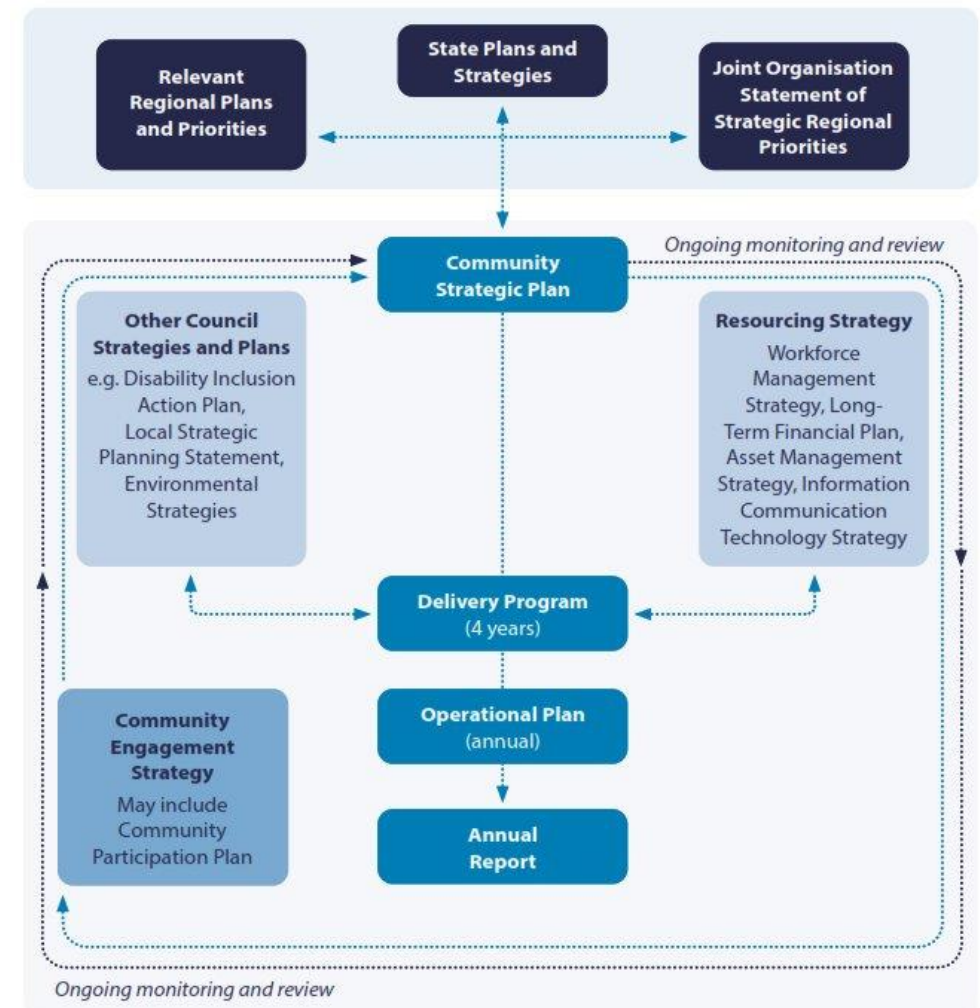

# Community Strategic Plan (10 years)

- Shoalhaven 2032 – adopted 2022 : 4 Themes & 11 Key Priorities
- Highest level of strategic plan
- Reviewed and updated after each election
- What is important to the community?
- Articulates vision and reflects aspirations
- Not everything in the plan is Council's responsibility

## Key Priorities

The community came up with several priorities that are important. These were categorised into four themes for our city.



### Resilient, Safe, Accessible & Inclusive Communities

- 1.1 Support inclusive, safe and connected communities
- 1.2 Preserve, support and develop cultural and creative vitality across our communities
- 1.3 Support community wellbeing through fostering active and healthy communities



### Sustainable, Liveable Environments

- 2.1 Manage our infrastructure for long term sustainability to meet community need
- 2.2 Manage growth and development with respect for environmental & community values
- 2.3 Protect the natural environment and enhance sustainability



### Thriving local economies that meet community needs

- 3.1 Strengthen and diversify the economy
- 3.2 Deliver safe, vibrant & attractive public spaces



### Effective, Responsible & Authentic Leadership

- 4.1 Deliver reliable, high quality services
- 4.2 Provide transparent leadership through effective government and administration
- 4.3 Inform and engage with the community about the decisions that affect their lives

1. Where are we now?
2. Where do we want to be in 10 years' time?
3. How will we get there?
4. How will we know we have arrived?

Addresses social, environmental, economic and civic leadership issues

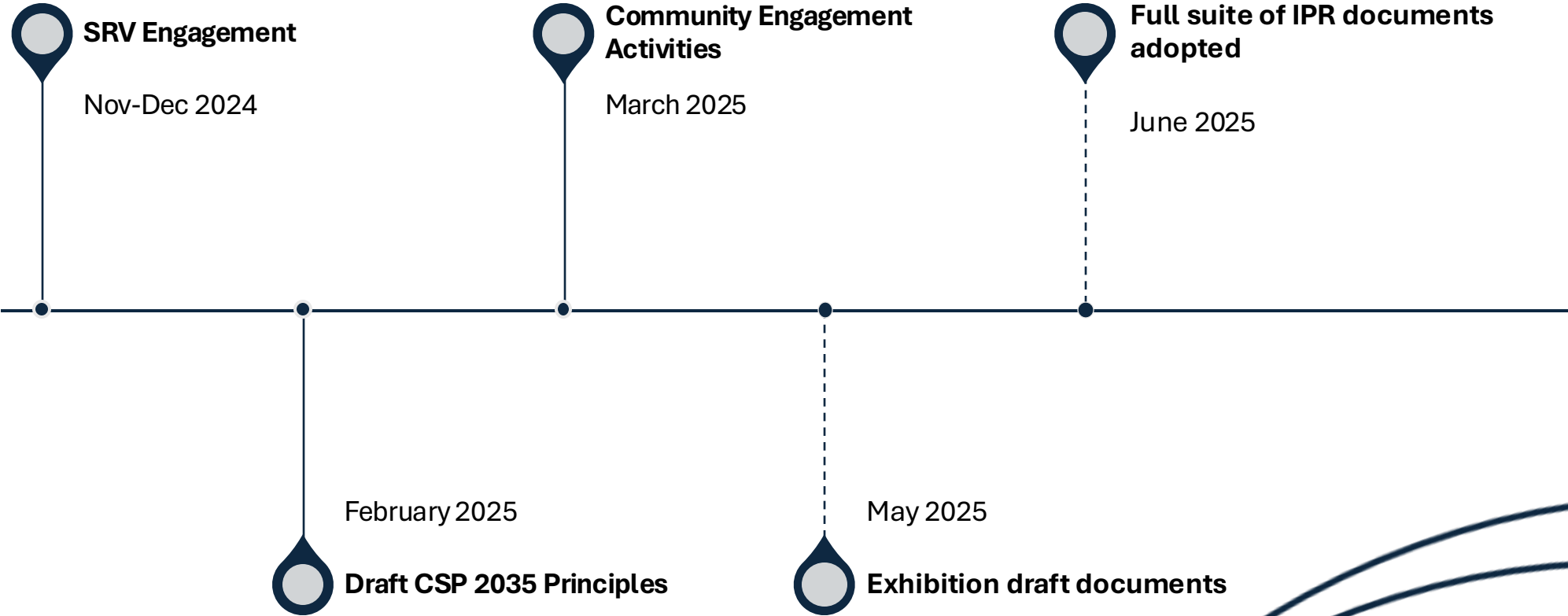
