Commencement of Bridge Construction at Smarts Creek, Croobyar Road

We are writing to inform you that bridge construction work will commence at Smarts Creek, Croobyar Road on Thursday, 8 August 2024 on behalf of Shoalhaven City Council.

The construction activities will include the installation of a temporary bypass track, removal of the existing bridge structure, and installation of a new concrete bridge.

Key Information:

- **Construction Period:** 8 August 2024 – 10 October 2024 (weather permitting)
- **Duration:** Approximately 9 weeks
- **Activities:**
 - Installation of a temporary bypass track
 - Removal of the existing bridge structure
 - Installation of a new concrete bridge
