82% of respondents noted the site is very important

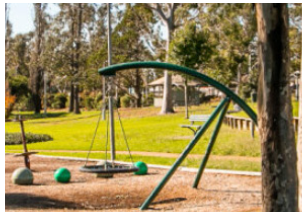


Lyrebird Sports Park, Nowra
