Introduction



This report provides a summary of community survey responses provided as part of a Shoalhaven City Council Community Infrastructure Audit 2024 (Community Infrastructure Audit / Audit).

The Audit included targeted stakeholder and community engagement activities to gauge utilisation and customer satisfaction data for a range of open space and community facilities. The engagement activity was undertaken from 22 May – 12 June 2024.

The Community Infrastructure Audit was undertaken by Xypher Sport + Leisure in close collaboration with Shoalhaven City Council's (Council's) Open Space & Planning Team and Asset Management Advisors.

The Audit provides a key base of evidence for the review of Council's *Community Infrastructure Strategic Plan 2017-2036* (CISP) by collating and presenting data on the provision, condition and use of open space and community facilities.

A summary of the outcomes of the community engagement activity is provided in this report. Summaries of the outcomes of the associated stakeholder, management committee and tenant engagement activities are provided in separate reports published to the CISP Review Get Involved page on Council's website.



Community Response - Overview



A total of 989 survey community responses were received through the Audit community engagement activity.


- Responses were received from a wide range of ages including:
 - 30-39 years old 218 responses / 22% of respondents
 - 60-69 years old 217 responses / 21.9% of respondents
 - 40-49 years old -181 responses / 18.3% of respondents
- Most respondents expressed general satisfaction with the 25 sample sites:
 - Extremely satisfied 157 responses / 15.9% of respondents
 - Satisfied 206 responses / 20.8% of respondents
 - Somewhat Satisfied 193 responses / 19.5% of respondents
- The top 3 reasons given for this satisfaction rating were:
 - Quality of Facility / Maintenance 641 responses / 64.8% of respondents
 - Range of Facilities / Services 495 responses / 50.0% of respondents
 - Access to Facilities 419 responses / 42.3% of respondents




