## Planned Temporary Full Road Closure Kangaroo Valley Rd, Stormwater Pipe Culvert Repair

Council is conducting stormwater repair work on Kangaroo Valley Road, Berry Mountain. The work site is located near rural address 321 Kangaroo Valley Rd, approximately 500m east (towards Berry) of the current landslip repair site.

A full road closure is required only for Sunday 22<sup>nd</sup> September from 7am – 5pm.

The road will be open contraflow in this location on Sunday night and during work hours on Monday 23<sup>rd</sup> September 7am – 5pm. Expect minor delays.

No vehicle access is permitted during the closure. However, pedestrian access under escort by traffic control will be facilitated as needed. Please note in a case of an emergency, access will be provided as soon as possible for emergency services.
