# Introduction

Shoalhaven City Council is currently undertaking a review of its Community Infrastructure Strategic Plan (CISP). To inform this review, a series of community engagement activities have been conducted to gather feedback from both residents and visitors.

In mid-2024, an initial engagement activity was carried out, assessing 25 sample sites to measure general usage and satisfaction. This provided a snapshot of community sentiment and usage patterns. The findings of this engagement activity can be accessed here:

Building on the previous activity, a second round of engagement was conducted from 13 December 2024 to 31 January 2025. This activity focused on 25 new sample sites and aimed to capture insights during the peak summer period, a time of high activity and visitor influx.

The primary goal of these engagement activities is to understand how the community interacts with the existing infrastructure, understand user satisfaction levels and identify areas for improvement. The feedback collected will play a role in shaping the strategic direction of the CISP.



# About the Community Engagement Activity

The survey was advertised through multiple channels, including the Council's website and Get Involved page, social media platforms, emails to direct stakeholders, and signage at each of the 25 selected locations.

A total of 929 responses were received.

Sites in high-traffic tourist areas were chosen to capture the experiences of both residents and visitors during the peak summer period.

Additionally, other sites not in tourist areas were included to gather more data on their usage patterns.

The selected sites across the two engagement activities represent a diverse mix of sporting facilities, destination parks, showgrounds, local parks, and community buildings.






## Open Feedback Themes

- There is a strong demand for public toilets.
- Demand for improved parking facilities.

- Additional amenities such as a permanent bike pump and more off-street parking are recommended.
- Positive remarks about the cleanliness and upkeep of the facility, including the care for native plantings and the availability of seating and picnic areas.




## Open Feedback Themes

- The facility attracts antisocial activities after dark.
- Suggestions to implement signage, ranger patrols, installing bollards, locking toilets at night, and adding CCTV.
- The facility and toilets need painting and repairs.
- The playground equipment needs better maintenance and upgrades.
- There is a need for more shade over the playground and sports areas.
- Additional amenities such as exercise equipment for adults, more play facilities and bike track.
- More accessible toilet facilities are needed.
- It is considered an important community asset.
- Better drainage and a more even surface for the sports field are needed to ensure safety.




## Open Feedback Themes

- The facility is often locked and not accessible for general public use for non-organised sports and passive recreation.
- Lack of access for parents with prams and general public use is a significant concern.
- Suggestions include adding a synthetic athletics track and improving access to play and exercise equipment.
- Demand for a designated athletics track to provide a safe place for runners.
- Utilising the facility for more programs and community events to increase its usage.
- Ensuring the facility caters to local residents, not just visitors from outside the area.




## Open Feedback Themes

- The facility, including the playground, amenities and pathways, needs an overhaul and updating.
- Demand for improved regular maintenance, such as mowing, cleaning the pond, and removing garbage.
- There are concerns about safety due antisocial behaviour.
- The park should be more accessible for people with prams and wheelchairs.
- The park should host more community events and markets.
- It is valued for its scenic views and as a place for social gatherings and mental health benefits.
- Planting more trees, especially around the lake and near the highway, to block traffic noise.
- Adding a synthetic running track and more shaded seating areas.



## Open Feedback Themes


- There is a strong demand for more play equipment to accommodate the growing number of families.
- The facility is poorly maintained, with issues such as unmowed grass and neglected equipment.
- Residents often take it upon themselves to maintain the area.
- Suggestions include adding picnic tables, shaded areas, toilets, bins and exercise equipment.
- Residents feel neglected and believe the facility should be upgraded to better serve the community.
- There are perceived safety issues, such as requests related to a stormwater drain and rubbish removal.






- There is a significant issue with rubbish and graffiti in the park.

- The park has potential to host a variety of community events, which would benefit the local area.





- The park has potential to host various community events, which is considered to be beneficial for communities in the area.




- The facility is not well-maintained, with issues such as outdated and limited play equipment, and wood chips that wash away with rain.

- It is appreciated for its natural beauty and peaceful environment.






## Open Feedback Themes

- Demand to add an outdoor gym facility and updating the basketball courts.




## Open Feedback Themes

- Some areas, such as the playground and BBQ facilities, need improvement.

- Improved lighting around the war memorial and better traffic safety measures are suggested.
- The facility should be more accessible to people with disabilities.

- There are concerns about the impact of large commercial events on the park's accessibility and maintenance.




## Open Feedback Themes

- The amenities block and toilets need urgent upgrades and more frequent cleaning, especially during peak seasons.
- More seating and regular cleaning of existing facilities, such as gazebos and BBQ areas, are needed.
- Suggestions include adding more toilets, showers, water refill stations, seating, shade and additional parking.
- Improved walking access to Moona Moona, for prams and wheelchairs.
- The facility is highly valued for its natural beauty and as a space for community events and activities like Parkrun.
- Adding clear signage for parking and pedestrian paths to improve safety and usability.
- Ensuring the area remains accessible and not overly commercialised, preserving its natural values.




## Open Feedback Themes

- The facility is appreciated for its accessibility features, such as the liberty swing and accessible bathrooms.
- The park is well-maintained and provides a safe and enjoyable environment for families and children.
- The toilets are frequently broken, not cleaned regularly, and have insufficient capacity during peak times.
- The outdoor gym equipment needs maintenance, and the bocce court is seen as a waste of space.
- Suggestions include adding more seating, picnic tables, toilets, separate change areas, covered BBQ areas, and better drainage systems.
- The facility should remain open space, with no more built structures, to accommodate large family gatherings and recreational activities.
- Installing a food festival area with live music and developing the sailing club to include a bar/restaurant.




## Open Feedback Themes

- The upgrades to the facility are generally well-received, with many appreciating the improvements to the playground, BBQ area, boardwalk, and overall maintenance.
- Lack of outdoor showers lead to people using hand basins to wash off sand, causing clogs and maintenance issues.
- The old toilet facilities described as inadequate and in need of renovation or replacement.
- Overflowing rubbish bins and inadequate rubbish removal were common concerns.
- Parking is a recurring issue, with limited spaces causing problems, especially during peak times.
- Demand for seating along the boardwalk and accessibility improvements.
- Recent upgrades have increased the popularity and usage of the park, benefiting both locals and visitors.




## Open Feedback Themes

- The facility is generally well-maintained and provides a peaceful space for the community.
- There is a strong call for permanent line markings to ensure safety and reduce maintenance costs.
- Better seating and grandstands are needed to support spectators during events.
- The sheds and change rooms are in poor condition, with many children preferring to arrive dressed to avoid using them.
- Requests for more shade, as well as a sealed car park and driveway, to improve the overall experience.
- Demand for drainage improvements.
- The sand pit needs covers to keep it free from sticks, leaves, and debris, ensuring a safe environment for children.
- Suggestions for an integrated pavilion, youth club facility, and basketball court to enhance the existing fields.




## Open Feedback Themes

- The facility is appreciated for its variety of uses, including the dog park, bike park, and playground.
- Poor grass conditions, and size of fenced dog off-leash area, lead to poor user experience.
- Gates are often broken, and the removal of bins has led to rubbish issues.
- The playground is well-liked, but there is a need for expansion and more shade to make it usable during hot weather.
- The community garden and other areas need better upkeep, with suggestions for more frequent maintenance.
- Requests for more seating, additional shelters, and stronger gates and lights for late bike rides.
- The need for a larger bin in the dog exercise area and better separation of dog and children's areas to prevent accidents.




## Open Feedback Themes

- The BMX track is in poor condition, with safety concerns due to holes, rocks, and worn-down jumps.
- There is a strong call for an upgrade to a pump track to accommodate various types of riders.
- The track's current state discourages use and fails to provide a safe and engaging environment for young riders.
- Safety concerns were raised about the wharf being overwhelmed when multiple users need it simultaneously.
- Requests for additional amenities such as sheltering or sun shading for picnic tables, more barbecues, and refreshed bathroom facilities.
- The BMX track has the potential to become a valuable asset for the community, benefiting local youth, schools, and attracting tourists.
- The need for larger jumps for older kids and a more challenging environment to keep them engaged.




## Open Feedback Themes

- The facility is valued as an essential green space with good amenities for picnics, play, and enjoying the natural environment.
- The toilets are leaking and inadequate, needing repairs and updates.
- The boat ramp and jetties are in poor condition and require maintenance.
- The retaining wall at the foreshore is considered hazardous due to erosion and perceived neglect, with a suggestion for a tiered wall to improve usability.
- There is a need for more parking behind the boat trailer parking area for trailers and cars.
- BBQs should be kept in working order and clean.
- The shelter and park furniture need regular maintenance to remain usable.




## Open Feedback Themes

- Demand for more fishing platforms for kids, tourists, and locals to fish from.




## Open Feedback Themes

- The tennis courts need resurfacing, with a suggestion for a synthetic surface to improve safety and usability.
- The basketball courts require line markings and additional goal post options, such as for rugby league.
- Floodlights and player shelters (dugouts) need upgrading to enhance the usability of the sports facilities.
- Public toilets need to be modernised and expanded.
- Improved drainage is required to ensure accessibility during wet weather.
- More picnic tables, shelters, and shade areas are requested to provide better opportunities for community gatherings.
- The reserve should remain available for community events and continue to serve as a meeting place for emergencies and large gatherings.




## Open Feedback Themes

- The current state of the area gives an impression of neglect, with concerns about safety and cleanliness.




## Open Feedback Themes

- The park is frequently used for family outings, picnics, and as a rest stop for travellers.
- Demand for additional equipment like swings and sunshades.
- There is a lack of footpaths between Milton township and the park, making it difficult for parents with prams, the elderly, and people with disabilities to access the park safely.
- There is a call for improved and modernised toilet facilities.
- The park would benefit from more regular mowing and maintenance to keep the grass short and the area clean.
- The car park is too small, and the driveway is too narrow to handle weekend traffic.
- Demand for more picnic tables and water refill stations.
- A BBQ and covered seating area would be useful for community events.




## Open Feedback Themes

- Some infrastructure needs updating to maintain the facility's high standards.




## Open Feedback Themes

- Suggestions for additional facilities include a second basketball court, a skate park or pump track, and an amphitheatre for live music.




## Open Feedback Themes

- Demand for fencing around the playground park for improved safety.




## Open Feedback Themes

- The facility is appreciated for its potential and current use, with calls to keep upgrading it in line with the adopted master plan.

- The croquet club is seen as underutilised compared to other sports facilities at this location.


