

As the manager of the local road network in the Shoalhaven, Council undertakes planned (asset management) and unplanned (emergency) roadworks.

Where roadworks hinder the normal passage of traffic, Council implements various traffic management strategies. These strategies include measures such as temporary lane closures, full lane closures, full road closure, escorted passage or detours.

Council notifies Emergency Services (Police, Ambulance and Fire) and Community Services (buses, utilities, agencies) of the specifics of the roadworks. When notified these organisations set up protocols to ensure they can provide their service.

In the case of a 000 emergency the relevant service will assess the response required and dispatch units accordingly, this may include an aerial response if deemed appropriate.
