Notification of the Works
Bream Beach Water Main and Naval Parade Sewer Main Relocation

Council wishes to inform you of the upcoming works associated with the relocation of the water-main in Bream Beach and sewer-main along Naval Parade, Erowal Bay.

Project Overview:

- **Bream Beach Water Main:** The water-main through Bream Beach is identified as a critical main (being the only water-main that supplies Wrights Beach), with the existing service becoming increasingly problematic due to its age, pipe type, and current location (underneath a caravan park). Shoalhaven Water intends to upgrade the water-main to a more secure location, to improve service and reduce risk of ongoing breakages.
- **Naval Parade Sewer Main:** The current sewer main from Wrights Beach currently discharges into the existing sewer gravity main located along the St Georges Basin foreshore. The existing sewer main continues to be impacted from storm events and erosion within the Basin and has been identified in the associated Coastal Management Plan to be relocated to Naval Parade to reduce the risk of future discharges into St Georges Basin.

Shoalhaven Water recognise that the nature of the works may impose some local impact in your area and will work with the contractor to keep these impacts to a minimum. Council notes it is not expected that the nature of the works will interrupt any residential supply service.

Residents living in proximity to your address, may experience a temporary increase in truck movements, noise generation and works in roads. All contractors and council staff will observe safe speed limits, implement appropriate traffic control management plans and limit works to approved acceptable hours of works.

It is anticipated that the duration of the work is estimated to occur across 12 months, with works onsite to commence in February 2024.
