Community Survey Results

During August and September 2021, the community was invited to participate in an online survey to inform our review of the Milton Ulladulla Structure Plan (MUSP). The purpose of the survey was to gain an understanding of housing demand and preferences within the Milton-Ulladulla Study Area to help us better understand how people live now, and also how and where they would like to be living in the future.

We sought feedback on:

- Current housing (household size, type, location, and suitability).
- Desired future housing (type and location).
- The future housing needs of family members.
- Experiences with housing affordability.
- Values relating to rural, scenic, and environmental land, and built form within the Ulladulla Town Centre.

We received over 270 responses to the survey. This feedback was used to help us determine where and how growth could occur within the Study Area over the next 25-30 years.
