To assist land use agencies and private property owners within the Bomaderry Creek bushland to better manage the environmental, cultural and recreational resources of the bushland.

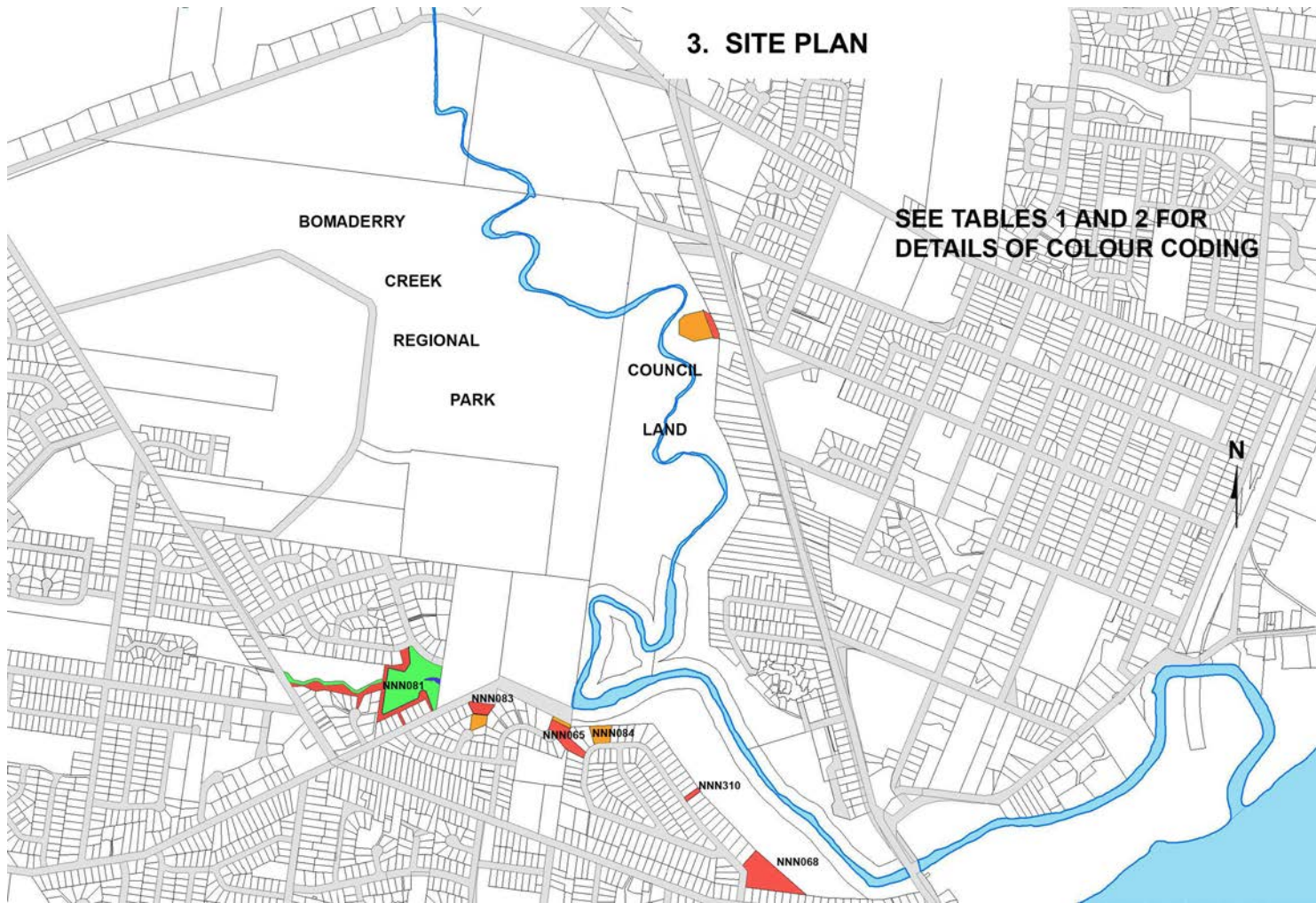
Work involves environmental surveys and assessment, rehabilitation of disturbed bushland involving weed and feral animal control, planting and erosion control, community awareness, education and training.

COLOUR CODE	CONDITION OF BUSHLAND	DESCRIPTION	INTERVENTION REQUIRED
GREEN	GOOD	Virtually weed free – healthy native community (0-10% weed)	1. Minimal
BLUE	FAIR	Minor infestation of weeds (10-30%weed)	2. Low
ORANGE	POOR	Severely infested – regeneration of native species being suppressed (30-70% weed)	3. Medium
RED	VERY POOR	Bushland replaced by exotic species OR only mature specimens of highest stratum remain – no seedlings or saplings due to infestation by exotics (70-100% weed)	4. Medium or High

TABLE 2: Degree of Intervention Required

LEVEL OF INTERVENTION	DESCRIPTION
Minimal (Green) Level 1	Resilience high. Removal of scattered weed & prevention of future impacts may be required
Low (Blue) Level 2	Resilience high to medium. Removal of scattered weed and active management of impacts required
Medium (Orange) Level 3	Resilience impaired but existent. Removal of weeds and removal of impacts required
High (Red) Level 4	Resilience low or seriously limited – may need reconstruction, fabrication or reinstatement to approximate the original ecosystem
