Traffic study for Huskisson

Shoalhaven City Council has appointed traffic and transport consultants Greg Tucker & Associates (GTA) to carry out the Huskisson Traffic Study.

Detailed traffic surveys have now been completed and the traffic study which Council expects to be completed between May and August 2010. The study will include an investigation into the feasibility of providing a bypass of the town centre as well as investigations of various options for town centre traffic and pedestrian upgrades.

Strategic planning data projections and traffic modelling techniques will be used to forecast future traffic conditions.

Following the initial Traffic Study, more detailed environmental and cultural studies may need to follow if Council resolves to proceed with the planning of the bypass after considering the outcome of the Traffic Study.

The community is invited to provide comment at an early stage in the study by advising Council of any ideas they may have for various town centre upgrade treatments which could be investigated as part of the study.

If there is any particular pedestrian or traffic treatment people want specifically considered for the town centre as part of the study then these suggestions will be considered.

If you would like to put your suggestions forward for the Huskisson town centre study Council will consider any written submissions made up to 4pm on Wednesday 26 May 2010.
