# **A Word From Vince**

The Recovery Helpline team continues to contact residents who registered with Council after the bushfires. Between calls, the team is reaching out to unregistered property owners identified by Laing O'Rourke as potentially eligible for Government funded clean-up of their properties. The clean-up is drawing rapidly towards completion and Council is intent on having most, if not all destroyed property cleared prior to Laing O'Rourke's departure from the Shoalhaven. Laing O'Rourke is confident it will achieve the State Government's target of cleaning up all registered and eligible properties by 30 June.

There are many pleasing Shoalhaven bushfire recovery indicators. Waste management has achieved a recycling rate of 93% of uncontaminated debris from cleared properties; over \$43m business and agricultural grant applications made, easing of COVID-19 restrictions and the steady re-opening of tourism, as well as the Spend Here This Year Campaign. Environmental remediations to restore waterways, flora and fauna are also in place and continuing. We still remain mindful of the significant distress and trauma felt by so many and the long road ahead for affected residents and visitors. Continue to stay safe and call the Recovery Helpline if Council can assist in any way.
