

## **PUBLIC EXHIBITION – PLANNING PROPOSAL PP049 DANJERA DAM ADDITIONAL PERMITTED USE (CAMPING GROUND) - SHOALHAVEN LOCAL ENVIRONMENTAL PLAN 2014**

A Planning Proposal (PP) **PP049 Danjera Dam Additional Permitted Use (Camping Ground) - Shoalhaven Local Environmental Plan 2014** for certain land at Danjera Dam Camping & Recreation area, Yalwal Road, Yalwal, will be publicly exhibited from **Wednesday 29 July 2020 to Friday 14 August 2020 (inclusive)** on Council's website at [www.shoalhaven.nsw.gov.au/Council/Access-to-Information/Documents-on-Exhibition](http://www.shoalhaven.nsw.gov.au/Council/Access-to-Information/Documents-on-Exhibition).

The PP seeks to insert 'camping ground' as an Additional Permitted Use on the land in Schedule 1 of Shoalhaven Local Environmental Plan 2014. This will enable Council to formalise the longstanding existing camping ground at the site and make planned improvements to its facilities and management.

The PP is supported by specialist studies addressing bushfire risk mitigation, biodiversity impact and on-site effluent management.

The NSW Minister for Planning and Public Spaces has delegated the making of this LEP amendment to Council.
