Proudly part of Shoalhaven City Council, Shoalhaven Water manages the collection, treatment and distribution of water in the Shoalhaven City. Shoalhaven Water also collects, treats and disposes of wastewater safely back into the environment.

Shoalhaven Water works with local industry to assess their water and wastewater needs. Shoalhaven Water not only manages drinking water but also manages a number of reclaimed water schemes and supplies raw water to local industry. Shoalhaven Water is committed to protecting the region's natural resources and works closely with schools and the community to recognise the importance of our natural assets for future generations. Shoalhaven Water manages some of the Shoalhaven's most scenic areas of wilderness and has some critical infrastructure located in these areas.

WHAT WE OFFER

Shoalhaven Water provides safe and reliable drinking water to approximately 100,000 people in the Shoalhaven on a daily basis. The drinking water supplied by Shoalhaven Water is routinely tested throughout the water supply system with analysis undertaken at independent NATA certified laboratories as per the 2011 Australian Drinking Water Guidelines (ADWG).

OVERVIEW OF SERVICES

Shoalhaven Water manages the Northern Shoalhaven Reclaimed water management scheme (REMS). REMS is one of the largest and more complex water-recycling schemes undertaken by an Australian local government water authority. The first stage has been in operation for over 10 years. REMS seeks to utilise up to 80% of the reclaimed water from six Shoalhaven Water wastewater treatment plants to irrigate local dairy farms, golf courses and sporting fields. REMS has won Shoalhaven Water numerous awards including the 2002 Winner for Reclaimed Water Management Scheme Innovation in Water Supply and Wastewater at the 2002 Engineering Excellence Awards.

Construction of the next stage of the scheme, REMS 1B, is expected to commence in 2017. REMS 1B will effectively double the daily reclaimed water supply managed within the REMS and increase the total area irrigated to over 600 hectares.
