

New and Improved Walking Trails and Accessibility Upgrades

The fifth update on the progress of this exciting project which is funded by a grant from the NSW Government, Shoalhaven City Council and Ulladulla Local Aboriginal Land Council.

D1 Plantation Point

The new amenities block is taking shape with the roof now completed.

The contract for the beach access ramp has been issued and construction is anticipated to commence in May, due to lead time for construction materials.

The final link paths and accessible parking will be completed at the end of the project.

D2 Palm Beach

This project has been completed. The new paths, BBQ's, shelters, and carpark look great and provide improved accessibility to this very popular location.

D3 Basin Walk – Stage 1

The concrete shared path along Sanctuary Point Road commenced in Greville Avenue and is continuing towards 190 Sanctuary Point Road. This section is expected to be completed by May. Residents will receive a letterbox drop notifying them of the next stage of works by late April. Existing driveway levels need to be considered during construction and Council staff are working with property owners to achieve the

best outcome. Every effort will be made to minimise the inconvenience to property owners.

D3 Basin Walk – Stage 2

A pre-tender meeting for the construction of the gravel paths and boardwalks along the foreshore from Palm Beach to The Wool Lane was conducted on 11 March with ten contractors attending. Tenders close on 7 April.

D4 Bherwerre Wetland

Council is awaiting environmental approvals. Design work is almost complete. Preliminary costing is being undertaken.

D5 Hyams Beach

Council is currently reviewing the feedback on the Hyams Beach Masterplan.

D6 Ulladulla Headland and Warden Head Walking Trails

Design work is underway with a GPS survey having been completed on Warden Head and Coomee Nulunga tracks.

Council is hoping to meet with Noel Butler regarding proposed One Track For All upgrades.

D7 Murramarang Coastal Walk Extension

This project will tie in with the National Parks & Wildlife Service's project in Murramarang National Park.
