St Georges Basin**



Reduce speed limit to 4 knots within Wandandian Creek channel in line with Estuary Management Plan (EMP) recommendation

**BN37**

Consider provision of reduced speed limits and no-wash zones adjacent to areas where bank erosion is occurring e.g. Blakett Park and Aloha Caravan Park foreshores

**BN35**

Undertake necessary investigations, design and approvals relating to provision of an on-ramp pontoon on the centre of the ramp

Investigate the repositioning and provision of additional navigation aid markers at the entrance to Wandandian Creek

**BN36**

Undertake necessary investigations, design and approvals relating to feasibility of steepening gradient of ramp

**BN38**

Undertake necessary investigations, design and approvals relating to re-design and replacement of pontoon with one that can provide adequate protection against southerly winds

**BN34**

Consider provision of reduced speed limits for power boats within Tomerong Creek to reduce erosion risk; consider restricting access to creek for power boats

**BN41**

Undertake necessary investigations, design and approvals relating to opportunities to provide designated off-street car and trailer parking for ramp

**BN32**

Undertake necessary investigations, design and approvals relating to the cause of scour at the toe of the ramp and solutions to reduce scour, repair concrete surface

Undertake necessary investigations, design and approvals relating to provision of skids/slipways for launching of sailboats

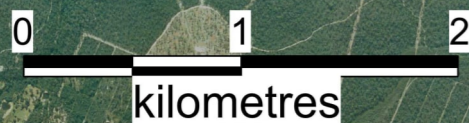
