Undertake necessary investigations, design and approvals relating to assessment of the integrity of the surface of this ramp and extending it to allow for launching of vessels when water levels are low

BN29

Remove from Council asset database, and non-powered craft encouraged to use the publicly accessible natural foreshore at Errol Bond Reserve instead

BN27

Berrara Creek

Provide a formalised storage rack or area for kayaks

BN26

Designate ramp for non-powered craft only except for emergency use
