Short Street, Lake Tabourie – Paddle Craft Launching Facility

Dear Resident,

Jirgens Civil, on behalf of Shoalhaven City Council, wishes to inform you that construction of the new Lake Tabourie Paddlecraft Launching Facility will commence on 14 April 2025. The project, located on the banks of Tabourie creek at the end of Short Street, will provide improved access to the lake for kayaks and small watercraft, enhancing recreational opportunities for the community.

Key Details:

- Work Hours: 7:00 AM – 6:00 PM, Monday to Friday, 8:00AM to 1:00 PM, Saturday (excluding public holidays).
- Duration: Approximately 10 weeks, weather permitting.
- Access Impacts: Short Street will be closed to vehicular and pedestrian traffic with the exception of resident access which will be maintained throughout the duration of the project. Pedestrians utilising the walking track along the creek bank will be guided by flag rope and bollards.
 - Preliminary Works from the 14th to the 17th of April – Minor construction activities.
 - Easter Break from the 18th to the 27th of April – Short Street will be open to the public and temporary fence will be installed around the perimeter of works.
 - 28th of April on – Construction activities to recommence and Short Street closures to be reinstated.
- Noise/Dust: Mitigation measures will be implemented to minimise disruption.
